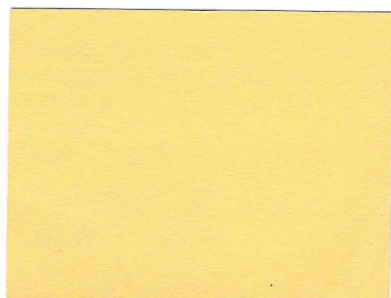

Dear Resident

A94 Angus Road, Scone - Carriageway Resurfacing

Perth and Kinross Council is starting essential resurfacing work on Angus Road, Scone (between Stormont Road and the A 9294 roundabout). The work is programmed to begin on **Tuesday 2nd December** and should last for up to two weeks, weather permitting.

Due to the nature of the work, a full road closure will be in place, and on-street parking and loading will be suspended. The closure will remain in effect evenings and weekends to ensure the work is carried out as safely and efficiently as possible.

The official diversion route will be via A93 – Cross Tay Link Road (A9294) – A94 and vice versa. Local access into Scone will be maintained via Stormont Road. We are also suspending parking and loading along the diversion route, but we intend to only enforce this at pinch points to keep local traffic moving. Temporary traffic lights may also be used at the A93/U87 Scone Brae junction to aid vehicle movements if required at peak times. Regrettably, the Scone Park & Ride Service will be out of use for the full duration of the works. Information regarding bus service changes will be available on the Perth and Kinross Council website.

Please see the enclosed drawing 3510252/01 detailing the works extends and diversion routes.

Vehicular access to properties within the works area will be maintained when the works allow and it is safe to do so. Please note that we cannot guarantee immediate access or exit from properties due to excavations and hot road materials. Traffic management operatives will be on site during working hours to help with residential access.

Access for pedestrians and emergency service vehicles will always be maintained, throughout the works. On waste collections days, please present your bins as normal.

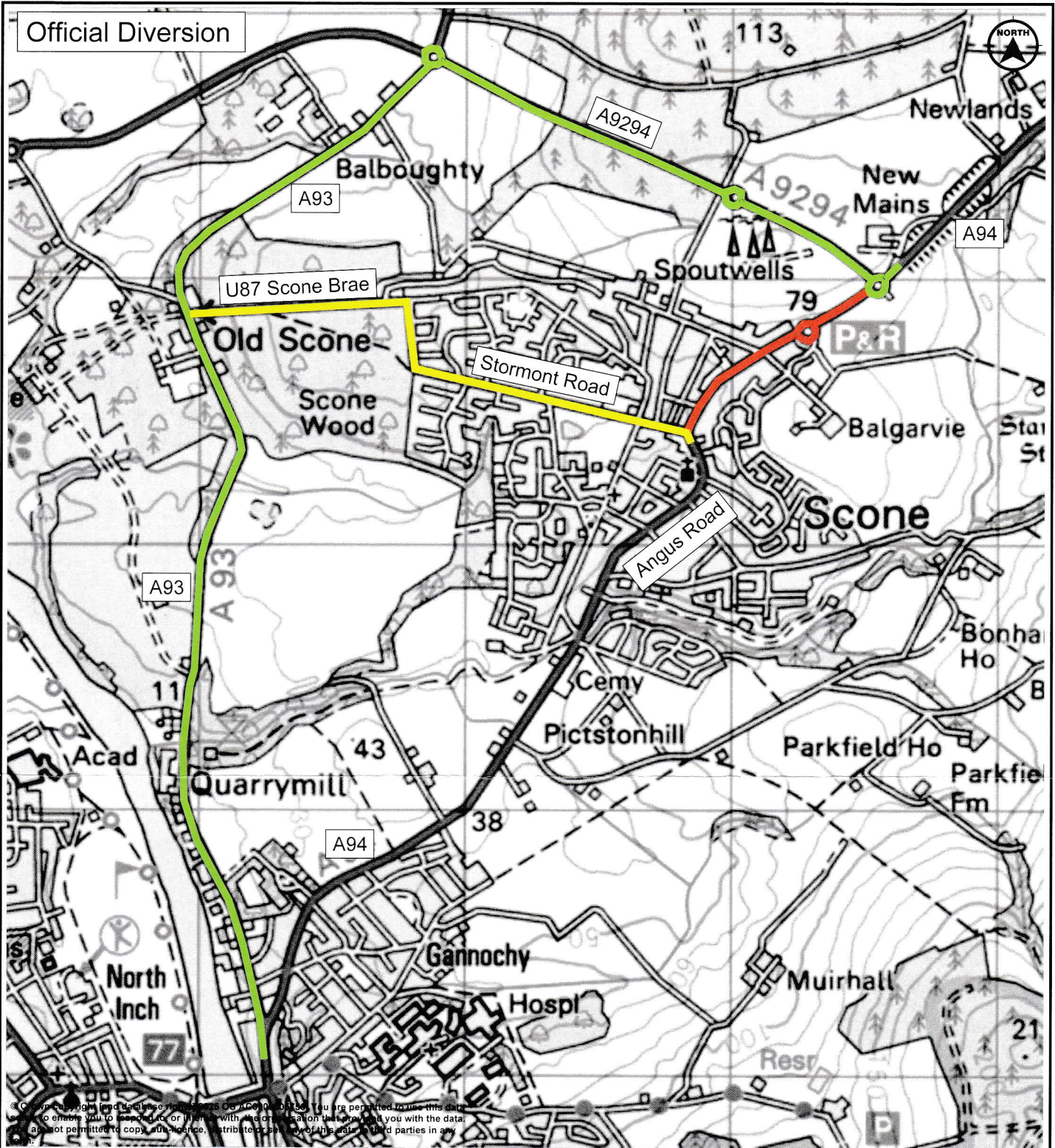

4. "Businesses open as usual" signs to be erected at key junctions.
